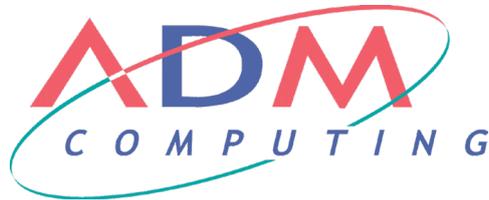
Layered security defences to mitigate against cyber-threats
